LAFAYETTE CHARTER SCHOOL POLICY No. 5.2.2 COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to reiterate Lafayette Charter School's commitment to ensuring that all families and students comply with Minnesota's Compulsory Attendance Law.

II. POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of Lafayette Charter School that all members of the school community, including all teachers, staff, parents and students understand the importance of all students' regular attendance at school. To that end, all members of the school community, teachers, staff, parents and students are responsible for ensuring that students meet the attendance requirements contained in Lafayette Charter School's Policy 5.2.1 on attendance and to promptly report any unexcused absences so that they might be dealt with in a timely and effective manner.

III. NONCOMPLIANCE WITH POLICY

Any Lafayette Charter School teacher, lead teacher, administrator or person providing instruction who refuses, willfully fails or neglects to perform any duty imposed by Policy 5.2.1 will be subject to discipline up to and including termination.
